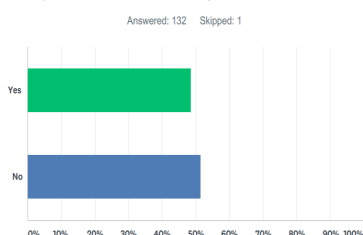
Our P&C have kindly donated 2 new sets of representative touch football shirts. We are very appreciative of their generosity and the students are looking forward to wearing them with pride.



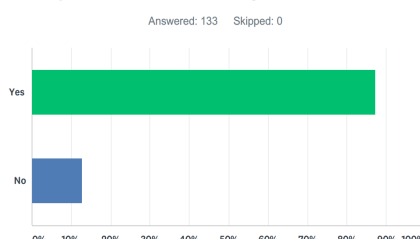
Girl's Uniform Survey

Support Unit staff and students would like to thank all of the above businesses and sporting groups for giving our students opportunities to gain new skills and access the community in fun and exciting ways.

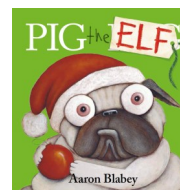


Library News:
