Presentation Day

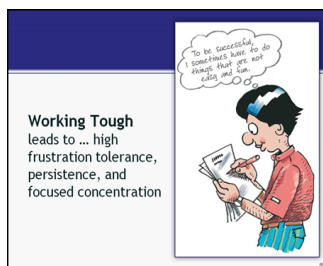

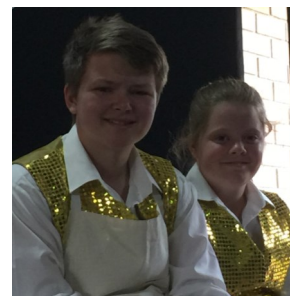

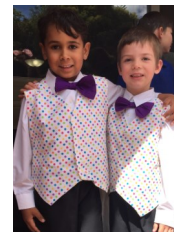
