You are invited to our annual Scholastic Book Fair.

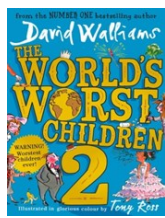
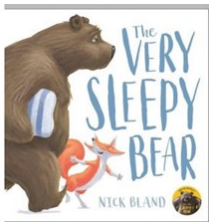
