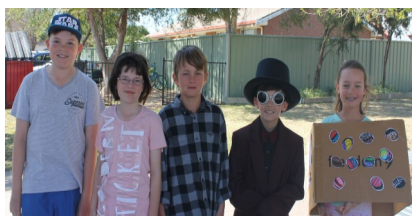
Roald Dahl Day
