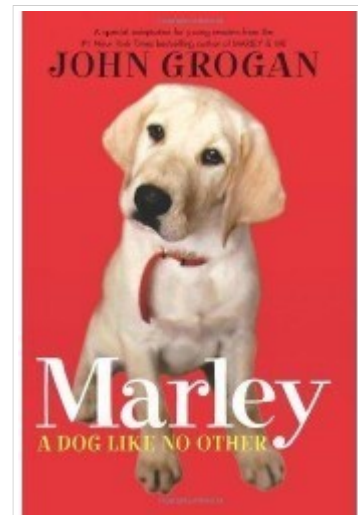
Book of the Week

Author: John Grogan

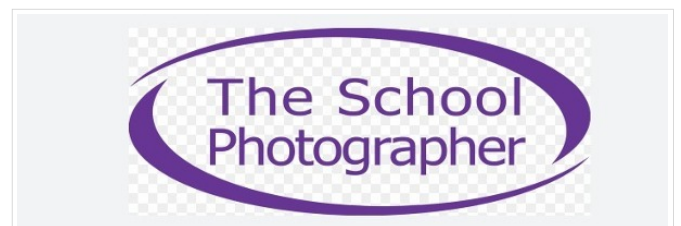

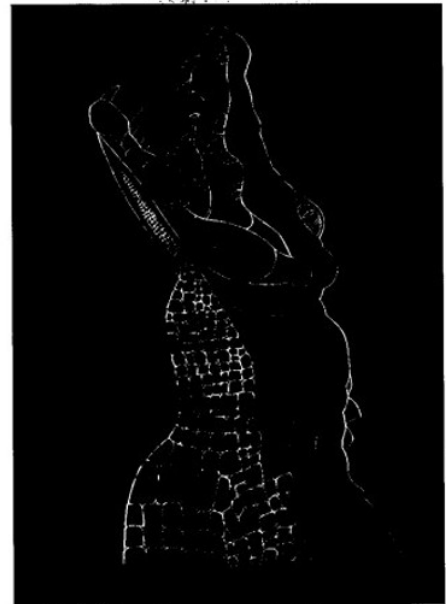

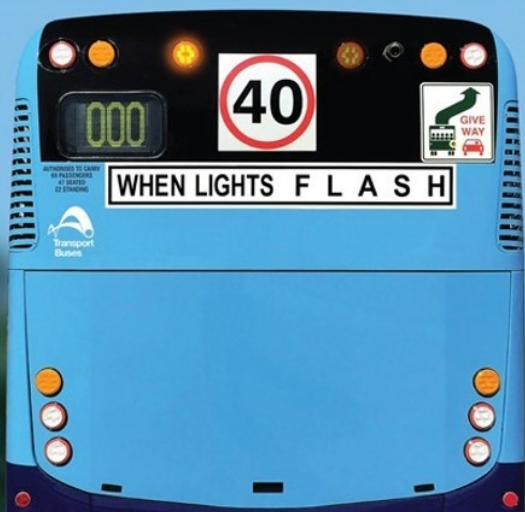
